# Anti-Bias/Anti-Hate Program: Trends from 2020-21



### **PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

- Started in response to rising anti-Asian sentiment during COVID-19
- Takes confidential and anonymous reports of hate/bias incidents
- Provides outreach, support and referrals to targets, and education
- Is trauma-informed and does not involve the police
- CISC is part of the King County Coalition Against Hate and Bias, a community-led initiative to address racism, hate, bias, and oppression
- Since July 2020, CISC has collected over 200 reports in King County in six languages: Cantonese, Mandarin, Vietnamese, Russian, Spanish, and English


